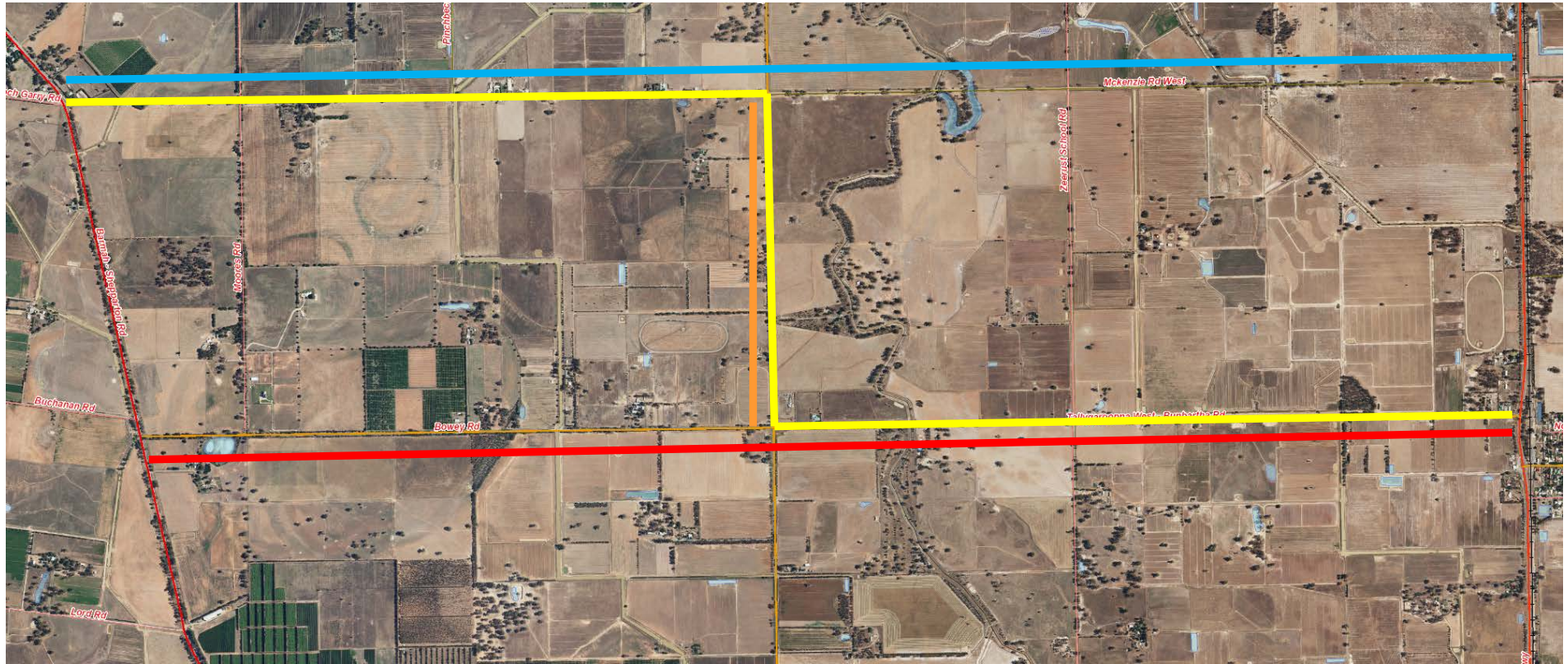

I am writing to request that our road name be changed to enable our property to be made easier to find. On no less than four occasions in the last 2 years alone ambulances have been lost looking for houses on our road.

Incident one.

The ambulance was not able to find our address, my son was just 9 days old. He has stopped breathing, it took the ambulance almost 25 minutes to arrive as they could not find our house.

Incident two.

My husband recently broke his leg and was left lying in a paddock while the ambulance attempted to find the address at which he was injured. On this occasion we were fortunate that one of the paramedics had local knowledge that our road did a strange dog leg and this is how they eventually worked out where to go.

Incident three.

Our previous neighbours Edna and Lindsay beer. Lindsay unfortunately had a stroke, and the ambulance took some time to locate their property. Lindsay sadly passed away as a result of this stroke.

Incident four.

Marg and tom Horton live on pinchbeck road, which runs off tallygaroopna west bunbartha road. Tom has a severe bee allergy, on one occasion the ambulance was not able to locate their property as they could not work out how to locate their property due to the way our road is difficult to navigate.

In addition to the above 9/10 times when someone tries to locate our property they get lost and end up a block away from where they are supposed to be.

We are asking that common sense prevails and that matter is addressed before an ambulance gets lost in a serious situation, and it ends in disaster.
