## The Purpose of the Shepparton CBD Strategy

The Shepparton CBD is the retail, business, administration and community heart of the City and region. It is important to make sure that the CBD continues to fulfil its role and meet the needs of residents and business operators.

With the continued growth of the population, the CBD is experiencing development pressures that could potentially change its direction and functions. The Greater Shepparton City Council has commenced the preparation of a Strategy for the CBD to properly guide future development, and to ensure that the future planning of the CBD reflects the community's values and aspirations.

The main aims of the project are to:

- Develop a clear vision for the CBD's future.
- Provide a framework for the future use and development of land within the Shepparton CBD and provide a clear direction to investors in relation to preferred locations for investment.
- Provide ideas for the improvement of streetscapes and public spaces so they are active, functional, appealing and safe.
- Develop guidelines about the height, form and design of buildings.
- Provide the Council with a plan for the better management of traffic, car parking, public transport and pedestrian and cyclist movement.
- Recommend ways to implement the Shepparton CBD Strategy as part of Council's Planning Scheme.
- Ensure the continual involvement of the community in the development of the Strategy.

## Who is involved in the Project?

The project aims to involve people who visit, shop, live, study or work in the Municipality, particularly in and around the CBD, including residents, tourists, students, key landowners, employers, developers, local businesses, community groups and organisations, and government agencies.

The Council is undertaking this project with support from the Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE). A Steering Committee of representatives of Council and State government will oversee the project.

1. **Issues & Vision** August / September
2. **Directions & Options** September / October
3. **Draft Plan** December / January / February

After March 2008, a final version of the plan will be prepared for adoption and implementation by Council.

## Why a new plan for the CBD?

The Council has continued to take a pro-active role in planning Shepparton's CBD. Last year the Council developed and adopted *Greater Shepparton 2030*, a Strategy Plan for the entire municipality. The Plan outlined a number of priorities for the Shepparton CBD. The CBD Strategy will provide the preferred direction of future growth and also articulate how the major challenges facing the CBD will be met.
