

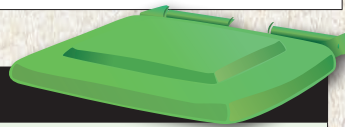
# Which Bin?

## Yellow Lid Bin



<b>GLASS</b>	Bottles (eg. milk, cordial, juice, soft drink. Lids included)
Bottles and jars (lids included)	Containers
Paper/cardboard	Ice cream containers
Boxes/cardboard (no waxed boxes like fruit boxes)	Detergent bottles
Cereal boxes	Margarine containers
Deli/ butchers paper	Plastic crockery (eg. disposable plates)
Envelopes (inc. with plastic windows)	Takeaway food containers
Greeting cards	Vegetable punnets (eg. tomato)
Juice cartons	Yoghurt containers
Junk mail	Take-away coffee cup lids
Long life cartons (eg. milk, juice, stocks and sauces)	All plastics numbered 1-7
Magazines	<b>METALS</b>
Milk cartons	Aerosol cans (cooking/baking spray, whipped cream)
Newspapers	Aluminium cans
Paper	Aluminium baking trays
Paper bags	Cake trays (foil)
Paper plates (clean)	Cooking oil tins (up to 5 litres)
Paper towel roll	Foil (clean and rolled/scrunched into a loose ball)
Phone books	Food cans
Pizza boxes	Formula tins
<b>PLASTIC</b>	Pet food cans
Berry punnets	Steel cans
Biscuit trays	Tin cans
Cake trays (plastic)	

## Green Lid Bin



Fruit and vegetable scraps
Meat scraps & bones
Fish and seafood (inc. shells)
Dairy products – cheese, yoghurt and butter
Teabags and coffee grounds
Tissues and napkins
Hair and nails
Lawn clippings
Garden prunings (inc. weeds and rose trimmings)
Twigs and branches under 100mm in diameter
Animal droppings
Purple compostable bags – Only those provided by Greater Shepparton City Council
<b>COLD</b> ash from the fire place

## Red Lid Bin



Batteries (dry cell)*	Smoke detectors
Ceramics/porcelain	Window glass
Coffee pods*	Broken glass
Kitty litter	Soft plastics*
Light bulbs	Clothing*
Nappies	Eye glasses
Ovenware and pyrex	Foam meat trays
Plastic bags	Foam underlay
Polystyrene	Pens and pencils
Scrap rubber	Take-away coffee cups

# Alternative options for disposal:



**Household batteries:** All batteries can be taken to the Shepparton, Ardmona and Murchison Resource Recovery Centres for **FREE**.



**Coffee pods:** Drop off for **FREE** at Riverside Gardens Centre, 7715 Goulburn Valley Highway, Kialla where they will be collected for recycling.



**Fluorescent lights:** Fluorescent lights can be dropped off for **FREE** at the Shepparton Resource Recovery Centre, 125 Wanganui Road, Shepparton.



**Garden prunings:** (inc. Weeds and rose trimmings) Drop off at the Shepparton Resource Recovery Centre, 125 Wanganui Road, Shepparton. Charges apply.



**Recyclables:** You can drop off recyclable materials for **FREE** at our three Resource Recovery Centres in Shepparton, Murchison and Ardmona.



**Paint:** You can drop off paint and empty paint cans for **FREE** at the Shepparton Resource Recovery Centre, 125 Wanganui Road, Shepparton.



**Soft plastics:** Soft plastics, the kind that can be scrunched into a ball can be recycled for **FREE** at many supermarkets. Contact your nearest supermarket to find out whether they can accept your soft plastics for recycling.



**Mobile Phones:** You can drop your old mobile phones and chargers off for **FREE** at Council Offices, located at 90 Welsford Street, Shepparton.



**Clothing:** Got clothing that is still in good condition? Find a local second hand store to donate your goods to – there are many across Greater Shepparton.



**Household Items:** You can drop off household items in good condition, such as furniture, bikes and kids toys, for **FREE** at all three Resource Recovery Centres. \*RRC site staff will determine whether an item can be sold in the Shepparton Resale Shop.
