RANGER CAT TRAPPING PROGRAM CONDITIONS

Strict conditions apply when a Ranger Cat Trapping Program occurs:

- The Ranger Cat Trapping program is subject to availability and Council approval.
- The fees of the Ranger Cat Trapping program are non refundable.
- Council cannot guarantee that cats will be caught during the trapping program.
- Cat traps are used to catch cats only;
- Cat traps can only be used on a property within the Greater Shepparton City Council municipality.
- Trapping can only occur on the applicant's own premises.
- Trapped cats can be cats that are trespassing, are semi-feral and living on the premises or are owned by the applicant.
- A maximum of five traps will be set at any one time.
- The ranger will attend the property and set the cat traps during Council business hours only.
- Traps will only be set in an area that is out of the weather, away from dogs and other animals, and where it can be appropriately secured.
- Rangers will re-attend the property a maximum of twice each business day to collect any trapped cats.
- All trapped cats will be transported to the Shepparton Animal Shelter.
- The applicant is responsible for monitoring the traps and contacting the Ranger to arrange collection.
- Traps will not be set in extreme weather to ensure the welfare of any trapped cats are not compromised.
- Traps are constructed in such a manner to allow for the humane capture of various animals under current legislation. They are not to be altered or modified in any manner and must only be used to catch cats.
- Only plain fresh cat food, fish, chicken or meat will be used as a lure inside the trap.
- Traps are provided in a clean working state. If the trap is damaged or misplaced whilst at the property, the applicant is responsible for the cost to replace or repair the cage.
