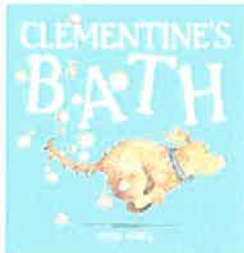


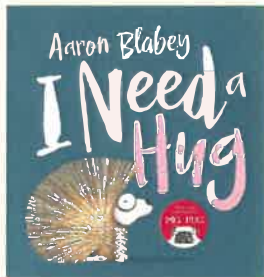

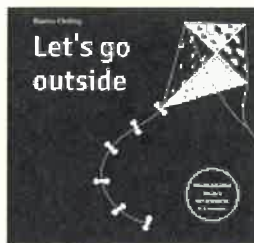

'Daddy up?' It's early in the morning and one little rabbit is wide awake....

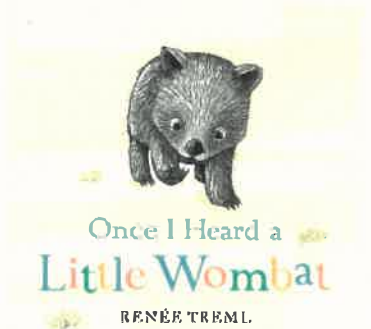
