Closed public consultation period – 17 April

As required in the Community Engagement Strategy a strategic document shall go on public exhibition for 28 days after endorsement by council before formal adoption by council. It is expected that formal adoption of the strategy shall occur at the May council meeting however this is dependent on the extent of public feedback that is received.

Our community has shown considerable interest in the progress of the Cycling Strategy with a broad cross section of the community involved in the development. There has been an emphasis on meeting the stakeholder expectations in regard to the consultation process and this can be seen in the resulting input summarised in appendix F of the draft Strategy.
