2014 PARKING IMPROVEMENTS - VICTORIA PARK LAKE

Springcar Nationals event working group have now made improvements to parking at the Victoria Park Lake throughout the weekend.

The changes will allow parking along Wyndham St between Vaughan St and the Shell Service Station throughout the day until 9 pm. From 9 pm on Friday, Saturday and Sunday a Tow Away Zone will be in place until 6 am. The Springcar Nationals event working group have made these changes to allow the community and visitors greater access to the public open space at the Victoria Park Lake but also allow improved safety measures to be in place to manage the event.

STREET CRUISE PARADE

Street Cruise Parade on Saturday, 29 November departing from the Showgrounds at 4 pm. Full road closure along Fryers Street until parade reaches the corner of Maude Street (approx. 30 min).

Vehicles will hold a static display in this location and roads affected are as follows:

- Fryers Street between Maude Street and GV Water
- Maude Street between Edward and Fryers Street

This area will be closed to traffic between 4 pm – approx. 7 pm. Vehicles will return to the Showgrounds again under total road closure until 7 pm approx.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS WYNDHAM STREET SHEPPARTON - Clearway times implemented

Clearway times are in place for Wyndham St Shepparton and will encompass the southbound area between Sobraon St, Macintosh St, and the northbound area between Macintosh St and Vaughan St.

The restrictions will be in place from Friday, 28 November through to Sunday, 30 November,

2014. The Tow Away time will be from 9 pm to 6 am each day. A \$200 fine applies for any vehicle booked for parking within the restricted areas.

All vehicles parked in the tow away zone during these hours will be impounded and owners will incur all towing costs.

TOTAL ALCOHOL BAN IN ALL PUBLIC PLACES (Local Law No. 1 - Community Living) - Penalty \$200

A total ban on the possession and/or consumption of alcohol in public places, including stationary vehicles and vacant private land, within the City of Greater Shepparton will be in force from 12.01 am on Friday, 28 November, 2014 until 11.59 pm Sunday, 30 November, 2014. Police will be enforcing the ban.

CHANGE OF TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

Wyndham Street
From 6 pm on Friday, 28 November, 2014 until 9 am Monday, 1 December, 2014 no u-turns will be permitted along Wyndham St or at the Dudley – High St intersection. No vehicles will be permitted to turn right into the Shell Service Station from Wyndham St from 6 pm Friday, 28 November until 6 pm Sunday, 30 November.

Thompson Street
– Fryers Street extension to High Street
Both lanes of Thompson St will be closed to traffic from 9 am Friday, 28 November to 8 pm Sunday, 30 November.

Fryers Street extension
– Thompson Street to Archer Street
The Southern side of the Fryers St extension will be closed to traffic from 9 am Friday 28, November until 8 pm Sunday, 30 November. There will be no parking on either side of Fryers St extension.

Archer Street
The left-hand turning lane into Fryers St extension will be closed from 9 am Friday 28 November to 8 pm Sunday 30 November.
