Clearway times are in place for Wyndham St Shepparton and will encompass the southbound area between Sobraon St, Macintosh St, and the northbound area between Macintosh St and Vaughan St.

The restrictions will be in place from Friday, 28 November through to Sunday, 30 November,

2014. The Tow Away time will be from 9 pm to 6 am each day.
