Benalla Road/Florence Street slip lane installation

Information Sheet

Greater Shepparton City Council is commencing works to upgrade the Benalla Road and Florence Street intersection.

The preliminary works are scheduled to take place in January, 2023, with the civil works to commence in February with the anticipated completion to be in April, 2023.

The works will see the installation of a slip lane for east bound traffic exiting Florence Street. The improved road design is to allow a more efficient movement of traffic through the intersection. This will increase user safety and decrease disruptions to the flow of traffic.

The project is 50/50 jointly funded by Council and the Federal Government, Heavy Vehicle Safety and Productivity Program. The estimated cost of the project is \$1,670,000.

Varying lane closures will be in place for the duration of the construction works. Traffic management will be in place to control traffic flow in line with the order of works.

Delays to normal travel times are expected and road users are asked to give consideration to these upcoming roadworks when planning their travel time through the intersection.

The works will include:


- Installation of a left turn slip lane for eastbound traffic exiting Florence Street
- Full depth reconstructed road pavement designed to cater for heavy vehicle traffic
- Reconfiguration of road infrastructure
- Relocation and upgrade of Goulburn Valley Water water main
- Improved road design to accommodate B-double turning movements
- Improved pedestrian safety
