

In June 2017, Council adopted the Shepparton Railway Precinct Master Plan (Master Plan), which outlines potential improvements for the Shepparton Railway Precinct to provide an attractive and practical gateway into Shepparton for current and future users.

The first stage of the implementation of the Master Plan has begun with the preparation of concept plans for a pedestrian overpass, and a network of shared pathways, which would provide enhanced pedestrian and cycling connections from the Railway Station to the CBD and Victoria Park Lake.

The implementation of any overpass would be funded and constructed by the State government. The preparation of concept plans simply seeks to better understand the options and constraints, and ultimately the costs, of constructing an overpass and the shared paths.
